

Eastern Radiological Associates (ERA) is a professional partnership of nine board-certified radiologists who have been providing professional radiology services since 1970.

The ERA team serves a broad area, including parts of Montana, Wyoming, and the surrounding areas, by providing the highest quality diagnostic imaging and interventional services in a caring and compassionate atmosphere.

ERA has seen 10-15% growth in the number of images needing to be read year over year since the COVID-19 pandemic, without an increase in staffing to match. All of this creates a perfect storm of conditions that potentially increase burnout.

THE PROBLEM

Picture a day in the life of an ERA radiologist. Using their legacy picture archiving and communication system (PACS), the radiologist arrives at the office and takes the following steps before they can begin work:

- 1 Sit at an assigned desk space
- 2 Login to the host computer and PACS to view images
- 3 Login to a separate computer which hosts a dictation system
- 4 Login to a *third* machine which hosts a second dictation system

At this point, the radiologist can start the process of reading the long list of images that awaits. Additionally, the doctor must view the image, medical record, dictated report, and PACS on separate monitors, using separate mice and multiple dictaphones or microphones.

This switching between machines creates a "swivel chair effect," causing literal headaches, back pain, and undue stress on the neck, spine, and arms. This is added to the mental and emotional stress of needing to keep each system and file at the front of mind to read and record the image properly.

What the system lacks in ergonomics, unfortunately, it does not make up for in terms of efficiency or risk management. Time spent switching between machines, calling subspecialists to the desk to read specific images, and inability to view the information all mean lost productivity, stressed workers, decreased client satisfaction, and ultimately—a negative impact on ERA staff and patients.

The legacy system was installed in order to help ERA take on new business in the digital age, but the technology was woefully out of date.




THE SOLUTION

ERA employed Sirona Medical, with a first-of-its-kind cloud-native unified workflow software, to help address these deficits.

The Sirona software uses principles of unification to unlock efficiency for ERA across:

- Reading
- Staffing
- Operations
- Interpractice Collaboration



Reading efficiency

The Sirona solution allows for all records and studies to be accessible at the same time, on the same machine. This provides both a roadmap to the day's workload and important patient histories that can improve outcomes.

The system includes everything a radiologist needs to do their work and can run on any computer with internet access. This allows ERA to simplify hardware from 5+ monitors to 2, all running from a single computer and single application with a single mouse and dictaphone attached.

Sirona also employs modern AI-powered features, customizations, and built-in templates to improve productivity, amplify quality, and decrease tedium.

Finally, unlike ERA's legacy software, Sirona allows ERA to control their own IT stack, instead of being at the mercy of disparate systems. This gives ERA greater control, security, flexibility, and customization options. Owning the stack sets the practice up for long-term success and the crucial ability to adapt to changes in study volume, site coverage, and radiologist staffing.

Staffing efficiency

The Sirona solution allows ERA to do more with less. Sirona opens the door to not only a more efficient but a more flexible workforce.

Because the system can be used on any machine, radiologists have the opportunity to read images when and where they want.

Since implementing Sirona, ERA saw a 470% increase in the number of studies read flexibly from home workstations. Something that had been uncommon for them previously.

Further, a work-from-home option and AI-powered tools simplify how radiologists read and are attractive recruitment incentives, allowing ERA to entice more staff members and partners to join the team in the future.

Operational efficiency

On the legacy system, ERA had designated stations where images must be read. Sirona has changed all of that.

Now, the images (and ability to read those images) come directly to the radiologist, wherever they happen to be—in the clinic, from home, even on vacation if needed instead of the radiologist needing to travel to the images. This allows for smoother scheduling and the ability to divide images based on subspecialty.

Interpractice collaboration efficiency

The problem of staffing shortages can be addressed by either hiring more radiologists (which is difficult in the current economic climate), or through outsourcing the work to like-minded partners with bandwidth.

Sirona's unified workflow software gives ERA the ability to easily share their workload with other local practices.

While offsite work was possible on the legacy system, it was cumbersome and required offsite radiologists to set up separate computers in their offices for remote access, disincentivizing business partnership and collaboration.

RESULTS

Through the adoption of Sirona's cutting-edge unified workflow software, ERA sought to address the negative impact working with their disparate legacy systems had on increased workload, staffing shortages, physician burnout, and changing reimbursement. These results highlight the positive impact of this transformation on patient care, accessibility, and operational efficiency.



Improved Patient Care

Staffing shortages affect more than just radiologists—the patients waiting for imaging results are adversely impacted by backed-up queues.

The ability to read from anywhere coupled with the flexibility to call in subspecialists from anywhere means an increase in both the speed at which patients get results and the quality of the analysis.



Accessibility for All

The modern features and customizations available with Sirona are not just convenient.

Personalized keyboard shortcuts allow radiologists to set up their workflow in a way that makes sense for their unique needs.

For example, left-handed users can perform common actions with their dominant hand. Shortcuts and templates also mean users can rely less on using the mouse, and can perform repetitive tasks with fewer clicks. Also, as a unified platform, users can setup all their shortcuts in one place for both viewing images and dictating reports.



Perhaps most impressively, the Sirona software has increased efficiency at ERA by as much as 25%.


